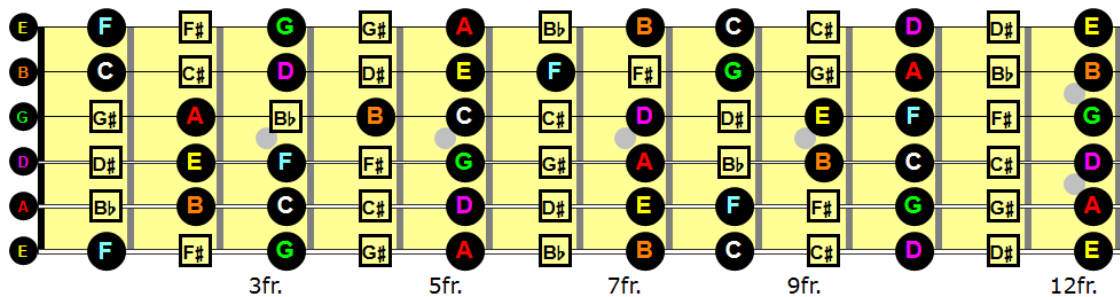
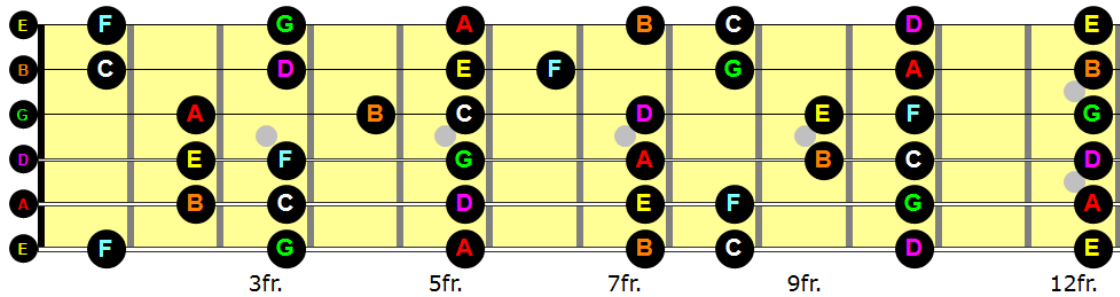


Naming The Notes On The Guitar

Here are two ways of naming the notes on the guitar



Horizontal Note Positions

Start with the open string letter. Then going sideways across the string, follow the alphabet (ABCDEFG only in a continuous cycle) for the following notes. For example the E string would be EFGABC etc. You always jump a fret between each letter except B and C and also E and F.

Vertical Note Positions

Going across all the strings, the notes follow the pattern BEADGCF. When this cycle of notes starts over, you shift up one fret. You also shift up one fret when you land on the "B" string.
